- Ability to create an age-appropriate environment in which children can flourish
- Ability to work cooperatively with support teachers, other colleagues, and the parent community

Responsibilities

- Implementing the prescribed weekly and monthly programme, utilizing the provided themed readers, phonics programme, songs and rhymes
- Conducting Show and Tell exercises weekly
- Maintaining and utilizing the English Team's inventory of educational materials, props and manipulatives
- Participating in relevant professional development seminars and workshops
- Attending all school events, such as Parent-Child Picnics and Christmas Parties
- Arranging English-language content and games for holiday celebrations
- Implementing biannual formal and informal student assessment
- Miscellaneous English-language support duties as assigned
